Example from Geography: Population Growth

Adapt the difficulty of your statements to your learners' level.

Choice of statements (C1)

1. Because our population is at seven billion people and continues to grow, we need to expand land area available for living and growing food by cutting down the rain forest.
2. With seven billion people commuting from one place to another, drilling for more oil is necessary to fuel more cars.
3. In order to feed our population, we must use pesticides, chemical fertilizers, and genetically modified crops to increase farm yields.
4. In a real crunch, jobs are more important than environmental quality.
